Applications as to acquisition of the citizenship of Latvia through naturalization accepted
in the regional branches of the Naturalization Board as of February 1, 1995.
☐ Since the beginning of naturalization process 151 495 naturalization applications have
been received requesting 165 019 persons to be naturalized.
☐ 149 425 persons including 14 666 underage children have been granted the citizenship of
Latvia by the decree of the Cabinet of Ministers.
As from March 1, 2010 the applications of naturalization receives in Office of Citizenship
and Migration affairs.
☐ As from January 1, 2023 to December 31, 2023, has received 1 280 applications for the
admission of Latvian citizenship through naturalization. Including applicants:
- Females -53,0%, Males -47,0%.
 Lithuanians and Estonians-2,4%, Russians-59,7%, Poles-3,5%, Belarussians-11,7%,
Ukrainians -9,8% , other- 10,6%.
□ 52,1% Latvian citizenship pretendents have passed the examination of proficiency in the
Latvian language, 82,2% have passed the examination of the history of Latvia.
595 persons have been granted the citizenship of Latvia accordance with degrees of
Cabinet of Ministers, including 19 underage children.
