

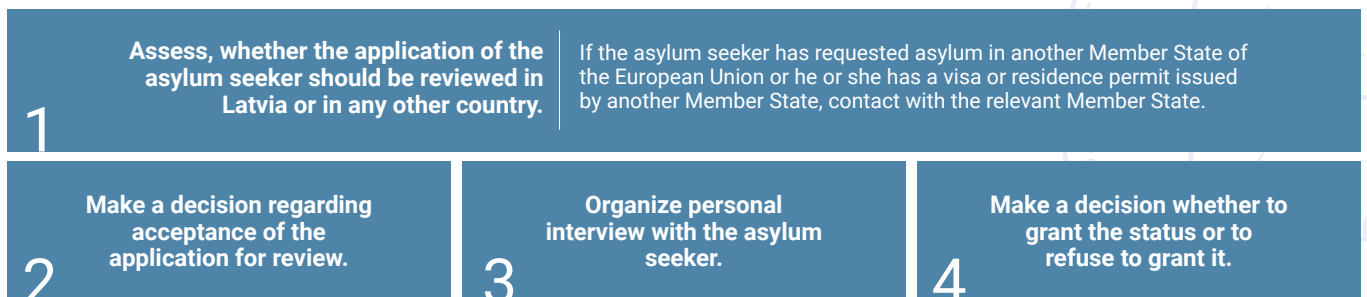
AFTER REQUESTING ASYLUM

State Border Guard shall:

- 1 accept and register the application;
- 2 verify personal identity documents and travel documents and keep them until the end of procedure if there is no any other ground to stay in Latvia;
- 3 establish identity and nationality of the asylum seeker;
- 4 take fingerprints (as of the age of 14 years);
- 5 establish, whether the person has not requested the asylum in another Member State of the European Union;
- 6 establish the reasons, why a person needs asylum;
- 7 may perform inspection of personal property.



Asylum Division of the Office of Citizenship and Migration Affairs shall:



Applications regarding requesting asylum SHALL NOT BE REVIEWED from the persons:



- who has been granted the protection by another state,
- who has any other first asylum state,
- who has arrived from a safe third-country,
- who submits the application repeatedly without specifying new circumstances.
